

Kitsuki City How to Separate and Put Out Garbage and Recyclables


Please follow the rules for the garbage disposal. Check the type of the garbage with it's collection day. Dispose in desinated garbage bags.

BURNABLE

Designated bag
もやすごみ袋 (TRANSLUCENT)

Use the city designated TRANSLUCENT bag
*If the garbage is too big to put into a designated bag, please separate it as "Oversized Garbage".


◇ Food Scraps ◇ Kitchen Oils




Drain all liquids completely. Use an oil disposal agent or soak in old cloths.

◇ Plastic Containers

← Items with this mark. Foods, Detergents and Oil Containers




◇ Rubber and Leather Goods
Metals must be removed




◇ Cassette and Video Tapes

Plastic protective cases are "NON-BURNABLE" garbage.

◇ Styrol Foam, Aluminum Items and Disposable Body Warmer




◇ Green Waste




Bunches must be within 50cm in length and within 5cm in diameter.

◇ Disposable Diaper



Flush human waste down the toilet.

◇ Clothes




Futon and Blanket Old Clothes Stuffed Toys Curtains

NON-BURNABLE


Designated bag
もやさないごみ袋 (TRANSLUCENT) PINK

Use the city designated TRANSLUCENT PINK bag
*If the garbage is too big to put into a designated bag, please separate it as "Oversized Garbage".

◇ Metal Goods ◇ Plastic Products




◇ Fluorent Tubes, Glass, Scissors and Cutlery and CERAMICS
Place broken glass and/or knife in paper bag or wrap with cardboard. Additionally, write "Dangerous" on the bag.



◇ Non-Recyclable Bottles and Cans

Oil Bottles and Cosmetic Bottles Aerosol Cans and Gas Cans




Empty all content. Aerosol Cans other than paint made of steel Are "RECYCLABLE GARBAGE".

◇ Small Appliances
Remove any batteries from goods.

Rice Cooker Hair Dryer Fan Heaters (gas, kerosene) Radio Cassette Players Always remove the kerosene.

@ These are not "NON-BURNABLE" garbage.

RECYCLABLE GARBAGE *GLASS BOTTLES

Designated bag
資源ごみ専用袋 (TRANSPARENT)

Use the city designated TRANSPARENT bags
*Sort by category before placing out for collection.

How to take out empty CANS, GLASS/PLASTIC bottles

- Remove the cap accordingly. Plastic → "BURNABLE" Metal → "NON-BURNABLE"
- Rinse thoroughly. Empty and rinse thoroughly. *Not "RECYCLABLE GARBAGE" when dirty.

◇ Glass Bottles




In the case of Beer bottles and Isshobin (sake bottles of 1.8 liters) place them directly at the designated

Foods and Beverages


Put out on the collection day of "RECYCLABLE GARBAGE *GLASS BOTTLES"

◇ Plastic Bottles



Determine if the PET bottles has a recycle mark. Remove cap and dispose as "BURNABLE"

◇ Cans




Metal lids are "NON-BURNABLE" garbage.

Beverages, Sweet tin and Canned food

*Aerosol Cans other than paint made of steel are "RECYCLABLE GARBAGE"

◇ Old Papers

Tie in bundles and place them directly at the designated station. However, Place in a transparent or semi-transparent bag on a rainy day.



Magazines, Books and Flyers etc.... Newspapers

Cardboard Paper carton

DANGEROUS GARBAGE

Designated bag
もやさないごみ袋 TRANSLUCENT PINK

◇ Disposable Lighter and Batteries and Fuorescent Light




Put into plastic bag and tie to the mouth of designated bag.

Items with this mark. Rechargeable batteries should be taken to stores that collect used batteries.

OVERSIZED GARBAGE

The garbage doesn't fit into a designated bag. Purchase Kitsuki City stickers(300yen) for collection and transporting "OVERSIZED GARBAGE". Put the sticker on each item.

Bed *excluding mattress Sofa Chest Stroller Bicycle Microwave

Regardless of size, it is "OVER-SIZED GARBAGE"


◇ Mattress with spring
Only the springs go in "OVERSIZED GARBAGE". Take off cloth and sponge.

◇ Tie Futons/Mattress without springs into bundles with string. Maximum of three per bundle.

Garbage that cannot be collected


Items that must be recycled by law or Garbage That Is Difficult to Handle.

◇ Computers ◇ Others



Concrete Blocks Drum Carbon Products Agricultural Chemicals/Poisons Fire Extinguishers Tires/Wheels Scooters/Motorbikes

Request pick-up by the retailer

- where you purchased the item
- where you are buying the replacement from
- The nearest electric shop

Bring to the designated location

After buying the recycle ticket at post office, you can take the item to the designated place yours ace yourself.
